HAPPILY EVER AFTER?

"Debunking the Marriage Myth"



Sunday September 16, 2012 Ephesians 5:21-33

"For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh." (*Ephesians 5:31*)

I. Popular <u>MYTHS</u> about Marriage ...

1. "The <u>PAST</u> is the <u>PAST</u>

Truth: Your present will someday become your past, and your past will eventually show up in your future.

2. "People who are <u>MARRIED</u> have <u>MARRIAGE</u> problems"

Truth: People who have <u>PROBLEMS</u> get married!

Marriage brings to the <u>SURFACE</u> things that were there all along.

3. "If I marry the <u>RIGHT</u> <u>PERSON</u> everything will be good"

Truth: You did marry the <u>WRONG</u> person.

The kind of "right person" you're looking for DOESN'T EXIST

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23)

Better Question to Ask: Am I <u>BECOMING</u> the right person?

II. The <u>BIBLICAL</u> View of Marriage ...

"Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ." (Ephesians 5:21)

Truth: Marriage is a relationship of <u>MUTUAL</u> submission.

We must have an <u>AUTHENTIC</u>, <u>ONGOING</u>, <u>VIBRANT</u> relationship with Jesus first!

1. Husbands: <u>LOVE</u> your wife as <u>CHRIST</u> loves the Church.

Husbands are to be willing to DIE as Christ laid down His life.

2. Wives: <u>SUBMIT</u> to your husband as to the Lord.

Wives are to be willing to <u>SERVE</u> the way Christ served.

Truth: Biblical Love is not <u>SELF-SERVING</u>. It's modeled on Christ.

For Reflection / Action: What myths about marriage have you been accustomed to believing? Why? How does your past affect your current relationship? How does marriage reveal personal problems? What are the things that you think make a person the "right person" for you? Is that necessarily the person that God may want for you? What does it mean to <u>Submit</u> like Christ? What does it mean to <u>Love</u> like Christ?
