I. The "Characters" as we continue The Story. 1 Samuel 1

A. A man name **<u>Elkanah</u>** in Ephraim.

B. His wife **<u>Hannah</u>** prays to God for a child.

C. "God Hears" and **<u>Samuel</u>** is born and dedicated to service.

II. The Three Major **Distortions** of God's Plan

A. The Distortion of **Disobedience**.

 Eli's sons <u>Hophni</u> and <u>Phineas</u> abuse the sacrificial system and commit immoral acts.

2. God **judges** them with death and the Ark of the Covenant is stolen from Shiloh. *1 Samuel 3-4*

B. The Distortion of **Conformity**. 1 Samuel 8

1. The people ask for a **king** so they can be like all the other nations.

But the people refused to listen to Samuel. "No!" they said. "We want a king over us. Then we will be like all the other nations, with a king to lead us and to go out before us and fight our battles." — 1 Samuel 8:19-20

2. God tells Samuel that the people are not rejecting him; the people are **rejecting God**

And the Lord told him: "Listen to all that the people are saying to you; it is not you they have rejected, but they have rejected me as their king." – 1 Samuel 8:7

C. The Distortion of Misrepresentation. 1 Samuel 9-13

1. God's "permissive" will, vs. His "perfect" will.

2. Samuel anoints **Saul** to whom God brings victory.1 Samuel 11

3. God <u>rejects</u> Saul as king and chooses another. 1 Samuel 15 The Lord said to Samuel, "How long will you mourn for Saul, since I have rejected him as king over Israel? Fill your horn with oil and be on your way; I am sending you to Jesse of Bethlehem. I have chosen one of his sons to be king." 1 Samuel 16:1
