The Beginning of the End Chapter 16 — August 2, 2015

- **I.** The Northern Kingdom, Israel, fell to the **Assyrians** in 722 B.C.
 - A. They become known as "the **lost tribes** of Israel."
- So the LORD was very angry with Israel and removed them from his presence. Only the tribe of Judah was left 2 Kings 17:18
 - II. The Southern Kingdom, <u>Judah</u>, had both good and evil kings.
 - A. King <u>Hezekiah</u> trusted God and defied the king of Assyria
