COMMUNION INSTRUCTIONS

As guided by the ushers, proceed up the center aisle, receive the bread then continue on to receive the wine. Dispose of your communion cup before returning to your seat. If you are unable to come forward to receive Communion, remain at your seat and the pastor/elder(s) will come to you at the end of the Communion distribution.

We believe in the real presence of the body and blood of Christ in Holy Communion. (1 Corinthians 11:23-29)

We request that those who receive the Lord's Supper profess the following:

I am a sinner. I have been baptized and believe that Jesus Christ gave His life so that I might be forgiven and live forever. (John 6:54-56).

I believe that Jesus Christ is actually present in this meal and that together with the bread and wine I receive His true body and blood for the forgiveness of sins. (Matthew 26:28)

I sincerely desire to live as a fully devoted follower of Jesus Christ.

If this is not your belief or you have not yet received instruction about this sacrament, we still invite you to participate in this way: by placing your hand over your heart instead of opening your hand, we will know that you have come forward for a prayer of blessing and not the sacrament.

PLEASE NOTE: The clear liquid in the middle of each individual-cup tray is a non-fermented fruit of the vine for communicants who must refrain from alcohol for any medical reason. Gluten-free wafers are available in the separate container on the paten (bread plate).

A ragtime aficionado since The Sting ragtime revival of the 1970s, Paul Orsi is a seasoned performer and composer. From a young age, he was a member of the old Maple Leaf Club and began professionally performing ragtime piano at age 13 in pizza parlors in and around Los Angeles. Paul has played his high-energy ragtime



style in a variety of restaurants and venues throughout Southern California. In 1983, he joined the elite group of Coke Corner Pianists at Disneyland, where he performed for 10 years.

In addition to his active performance schedule throughout the 1980s and 1990s, Paul has composed his own piano rags, recorded piano rolls and produced two solo CDs. After two decades of putting his performing career on hold, Paul is making his comeback on the ragtime scene. He performs at venues all over Orange County and is an active participant in the Orange County Ragtime Society and the Rose Leaf Club.
