SUNDAY SCHOOL & NURSERY INFORMATION

Parents: Nursery is provided at both services. Please check-in your children for Sunday School and Nursery at the registration table before the 10:30am service. During the summer we will not have Sunday School at the 8:30 service. The children start out in worship, then dismissed to their classrooms after the children's message. Parents pick up their children at their classrooms following the service.

SUNDAY MORNING ADULT BIBLE STUDY

Adult Bible Class – 9:45-10:30am Join us this morning! The Salt & Light Ministry will be presenting the first portion of The Truth Project lesson on 'The American Experiment'. It is a riveting, thought provoking lesson on the importance of God's Word on our Founding Fathers, on our foundational documents, and what results when God's directions are and are not followed.

COMMUNION INSTRUCTIONS

As guided by ushers, approach the Altar from either side. Proceed as far to the rear of the rail on your side as possible. You may remain standing if you are not able to kneel. Once you have received both elements, the elder will speak a brief dismissal prayer, after which you may stand and return to your seat. If you are unable to come forward to receive Communion, remain at your seat and the pastor/elder(s) will come to you following the Communion distribution.

We believe in the real presence of the body and blood of Christ in Holy Communion. (1 Corinthians 11:23-29) We request that those who receive the Lord's Supper profess the following:

<u>I am a sinner</u>. <u>I have been baptized</u> and believe that Jesus Christ gave His life so that I might be forgiven and live forever. (John 6:54-56).
I believe that Jesus Christ is actually present in this meal and that together with the bread and wine I receive His true body and blood for the forgiveness of sins. (Matthew 26:28)

I sincerely desire to live as a fully devoted follower of Jesus Christ.

If this is not your belief or you have <u>not yet received instruction</u> about this sacrament, we still invite you to participate in this way: by <u>placing your</u> <u>hand over your heart</u> instead of opening your hand, we will know that you have come forward for a prayer of blessing and not the sacrament. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: The clear liquid in the middle of each individual-cup tray is a non-fermented fruit of the vine for communicants who must refrain from alcohol for any medical reason. Gluten–free wafers are available in the separate container on the paten (bread plate).
