Judged by God's Law, each of us is a stray sheep.

### III. The LORD HAS LAID ON H\_\_\_ OUR SINS

And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death-- even death on a cross! (Philip. 2:8)

Get rid of the old yeast that you may be a new batch without yeast--as you really are. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed. (1 Corinthians 5:7)

### IV. WE FOLLOW THE GOOD S\_\_\_\_\_ (Jn. 10)

For Reflection / Action: Do I conform to others' expectations of me? Do I conform to the Lord's expectations? Or do I stray? Is rugged individualism good for God's people? When I stray, who gets hurt? If Christ bore all my sins, how many do I carry? Am I now allowing the Lord to lead me?
