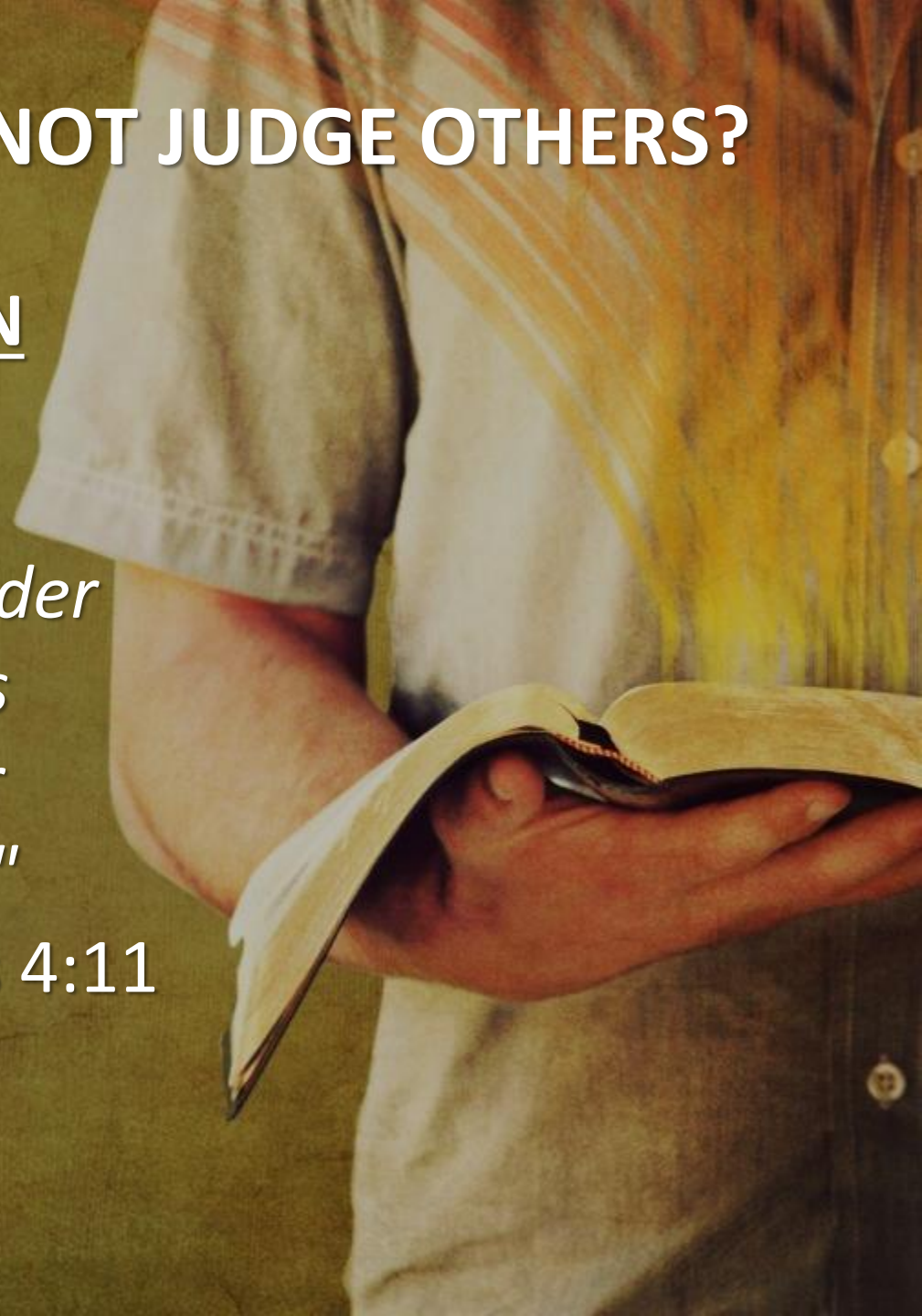

"You therefore have no excuse, you who pass judgement on someone else. For at whatever point you judge others you're condemning yourself for you who pass judgement do the same thing."

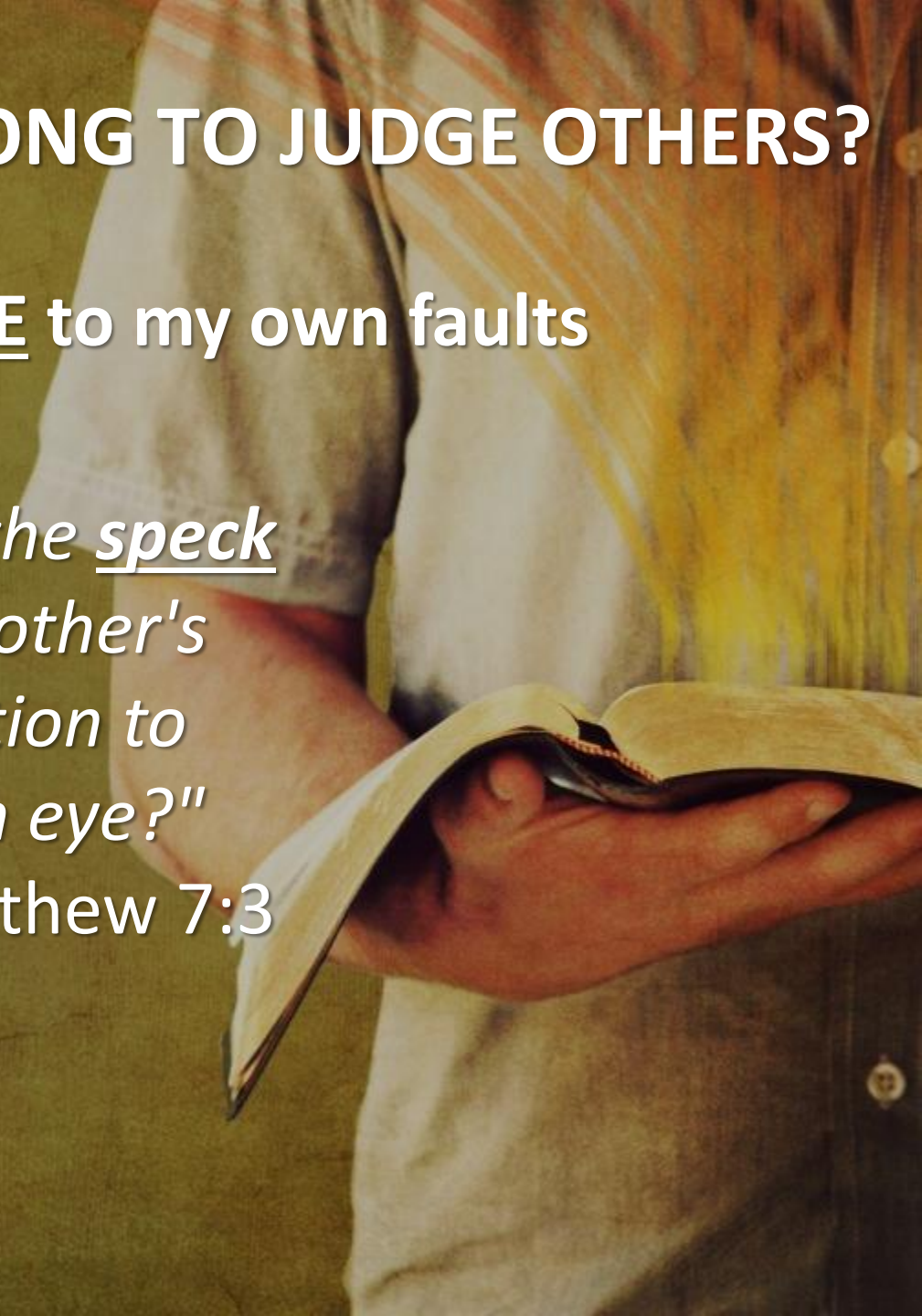

- Matthew 7:3

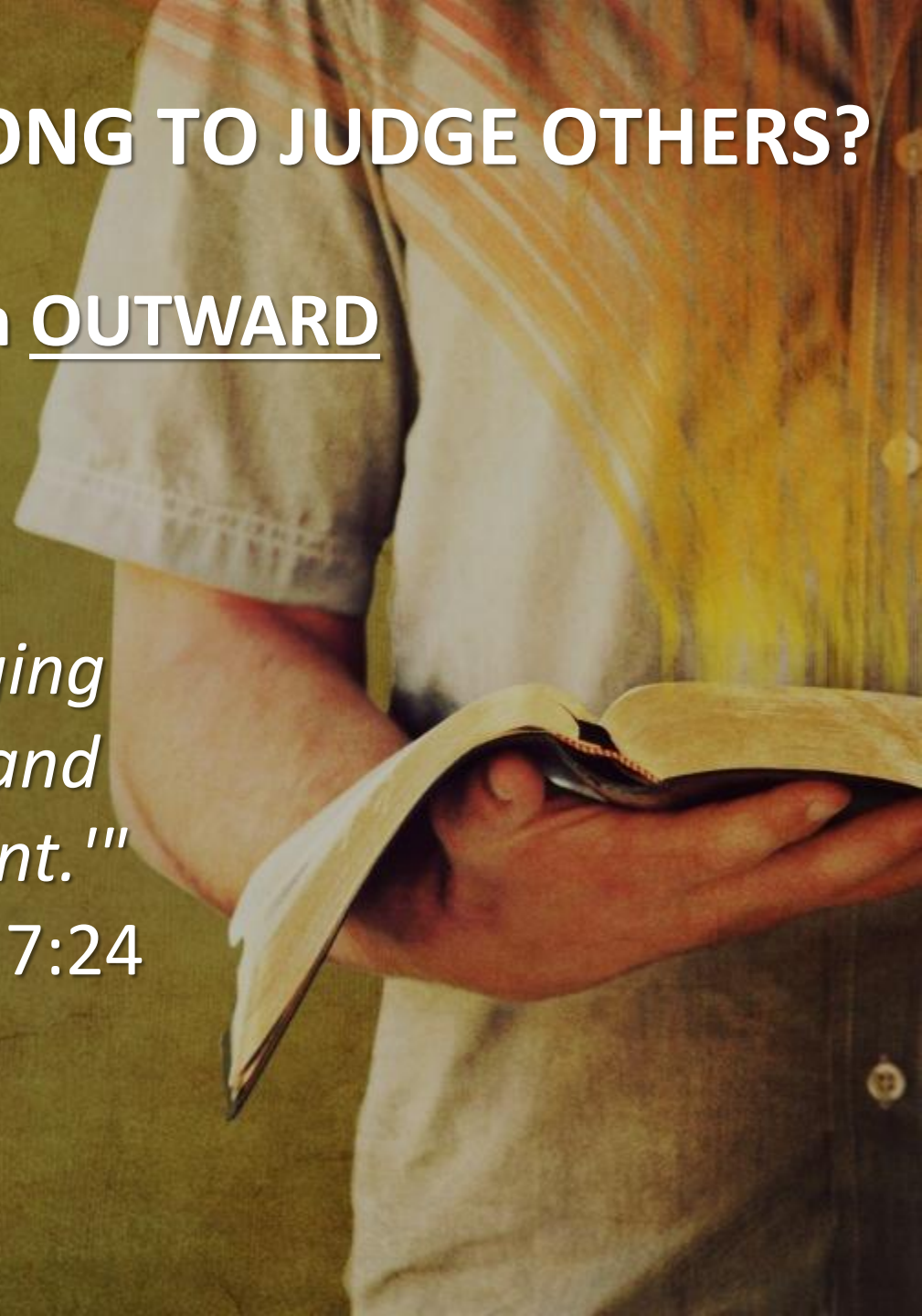


III. WHEN IS IT WRONG TO JUDGE OTHERS?
