What are some questions you've heard about the resurrection of Jesus? Did Sunday's sermon address some of those?

Dig into Scripture as you "consider Jesus." Consider some of these verses: John 8:54-58, Philippians 2:5-8, John 1:1-18, Romans 10:9-10, Colossians 2:8-10, John 8:24

What are some "Christ Plus" or "DO" things you've felt you needed to add to add to the completed work of Jesus?

Discuss the differences between religion and relationship.

<u>Pray</u>: Thank God for His unfailing love and for rescuing you from sin and death! Then think of someone who isn't so sure what they believe. Pray for them, and ask God to show you how to share His love and your faith with them.

<u>Do</u>: What is God calling you to do this week to show the love of Christ to people who don't know Him?
