## A Few Good Men and Women

Chapter 8 — April 19, 2015

- I. Israel's Three Mistakes after Conquering the Land.
  - A. They did not drive out <u>all</u> the Canaanites

When Israel became strong, they pressed the Canaanites into forced labor but never drove them out completely - Judges 1:28

B. The fell into the sin of **idolatry**. 2:12

They forsook the Lord, ... They followed and worshiped various gods of the peoples around them. – Judges 2:12

C. They did not teach their children about God

After that ... another generation grew up who knew neither the Lord nor what he had done for Israel – Judges 2:10

- II. Two reasons that God <u>raises</u> up the judges.
- A. God wants **other nations** to know His goodness and blessing.
- B. God powerfully **intervenes** when His people cry out to Him.
- III. The repeated **pattern** (or cycle) in Judges.
  - A. The people fall into **sin**.
  - B. God allows them to be **oppressed**.
  - C. The oppressed people **cry out** to God for help.
  - D. God raises up a **judge** to deliver them.
- IV. Illustrations of **flawed** humanity.
  - A. Gideon: A doubtful leader. Judges 7
- B. Samson: A <u>prideful</u> and <u>immature</u> leader.-Judges 13-16
  - C. **Today**: The cycle continues.
