- II. The Courageous Response
 - A. **Esther** is selected as the new Queen (Esther 2:12)
 - B. Mordecai convinces Esther to appeal to the king

 - A. Xerxes honors Mordecai not Haman
 - B. Esther arranges a private dinner and exposes Haman's plan.
 - C. Xerxes decrees that the Jews can defend themselves
 - D. Mourning turns to **celebration**.
- IV. God is in Control
