Prophecies that Jesus is the MESSIAH – King of Kings.

III. LOOK AT THE DONKEY'S O_____

"Go to the village ahead of you, and as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here. 31 If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' tell him, 'The Lord needs it.' " (Luke 19:30-31)

IV. LOOK AT THE D_____

(References: Numbers 22, Luke 2, Matthew 2)

For Reflection / Action: In the crowds that witnessed Jesus enter Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, who am I most like? What do I have that the Lord needs? Am I willing to give it to Him? Am I willing to let the Lord use me?


