2. When it **BLINDS ME** to my own faults



4. When it's before I hear THE FACTS

"Nicodemus who had gone to Jesus earlier and who was one of their own number asked `Does our law condemn a man without <u>first hearing him to</u> <u>find out</u> what he is doing?''' \_ John 7:51

5. When it's based on **EXTERNAL** observances

"Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat, drink, or regard to religious festivals, a new moon celebration or a Sabbath day. These are a shadow of the thing to come. Reality, however, is found in Christ." - Colossians 2:16

6. When it causes me to <u>SPEAK EVIL</u> about others
