

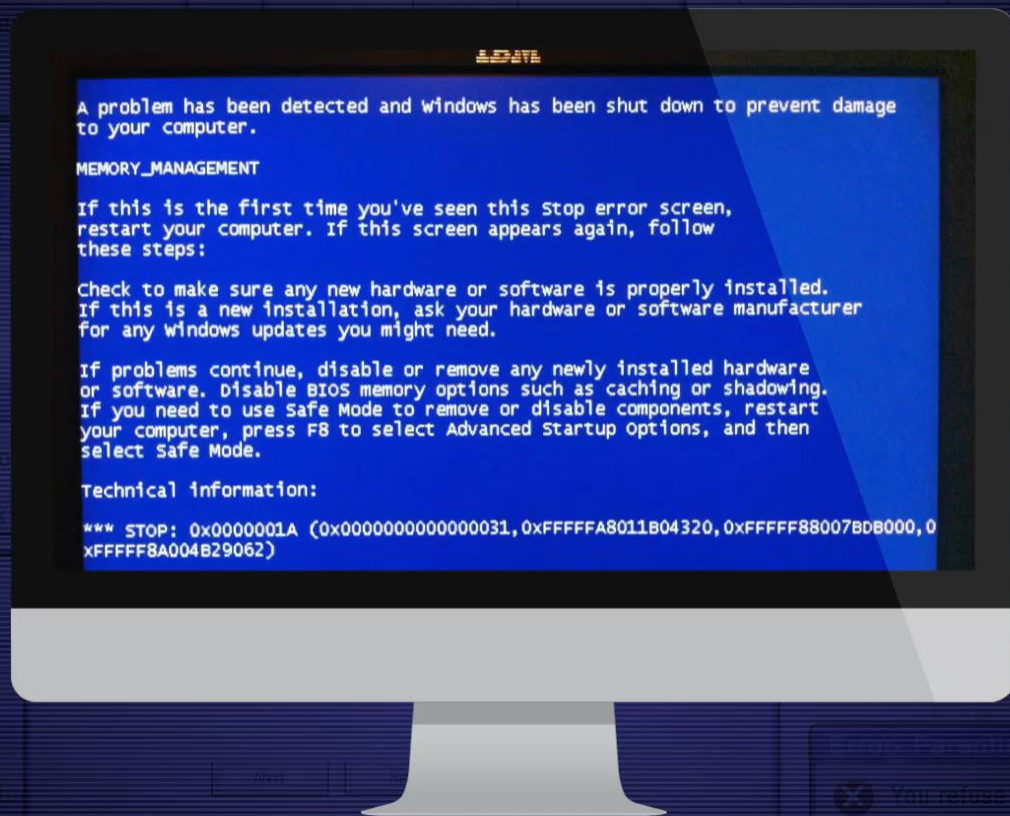

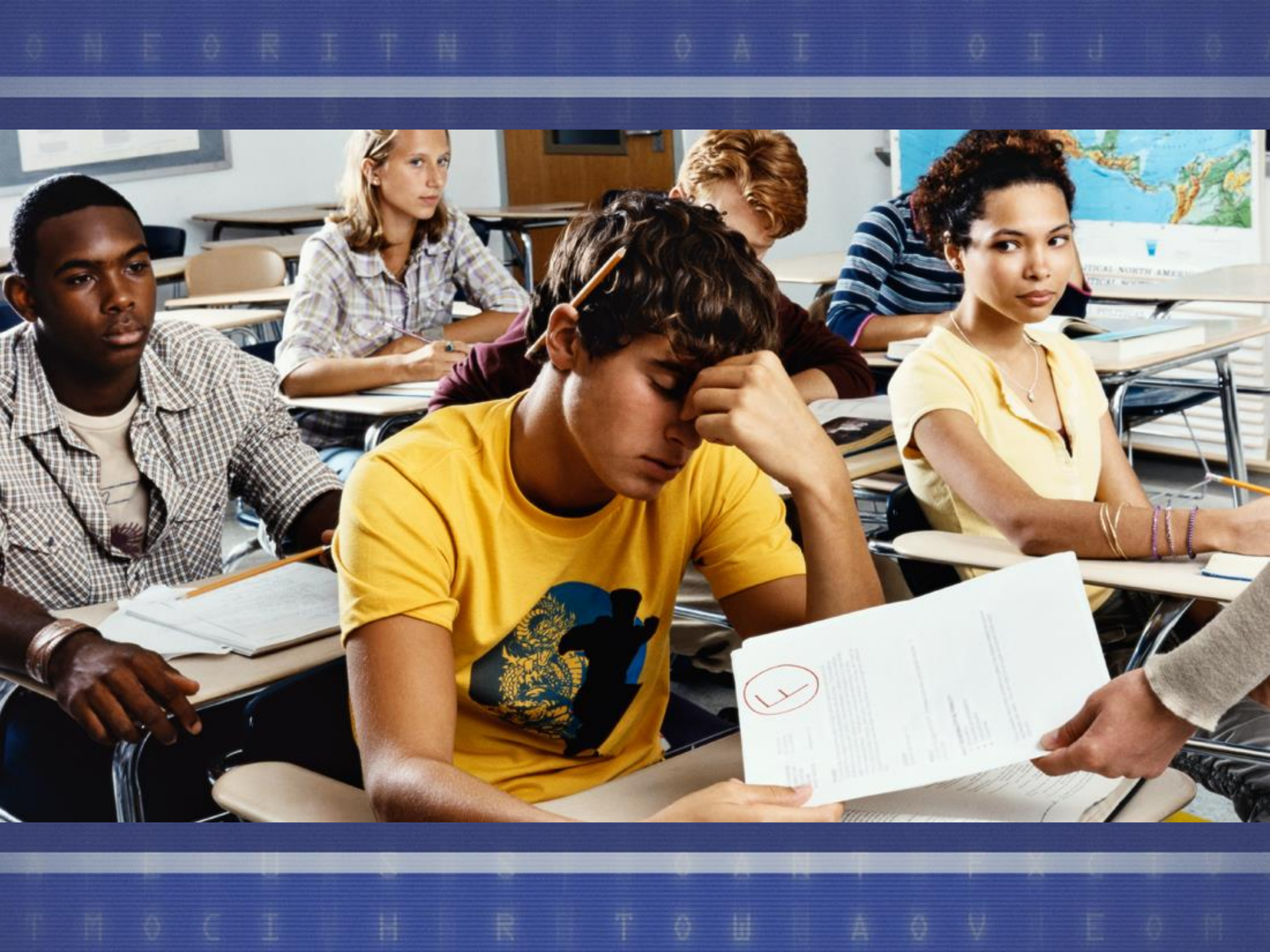

# **Self-Serving Bias Study by Thomas Gilovich:**

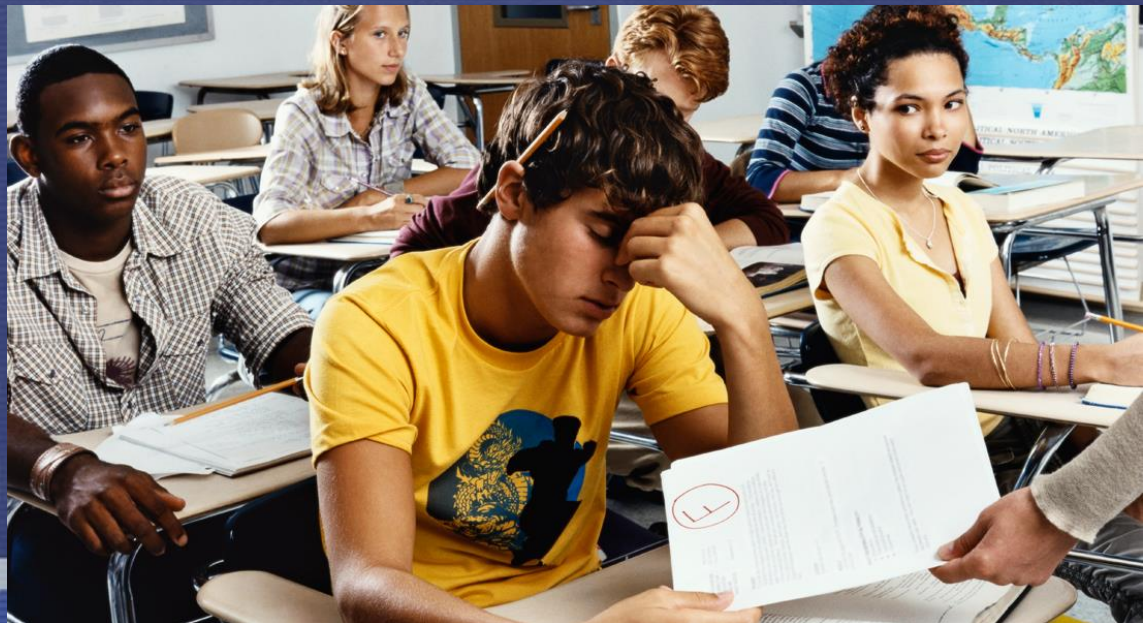
**- 100% of high school students rated themselves “above average” in their ability to get along with other people with 60% claiming to be in the top 10% and 25% claiming to be in the top 1%**



# **Self-Serving Bias Study by Thomas Gilovich:**

**- 70% of high school students rated themselves  
“above average” in their leadership ability, with only  
2% rating themselves “below average”**

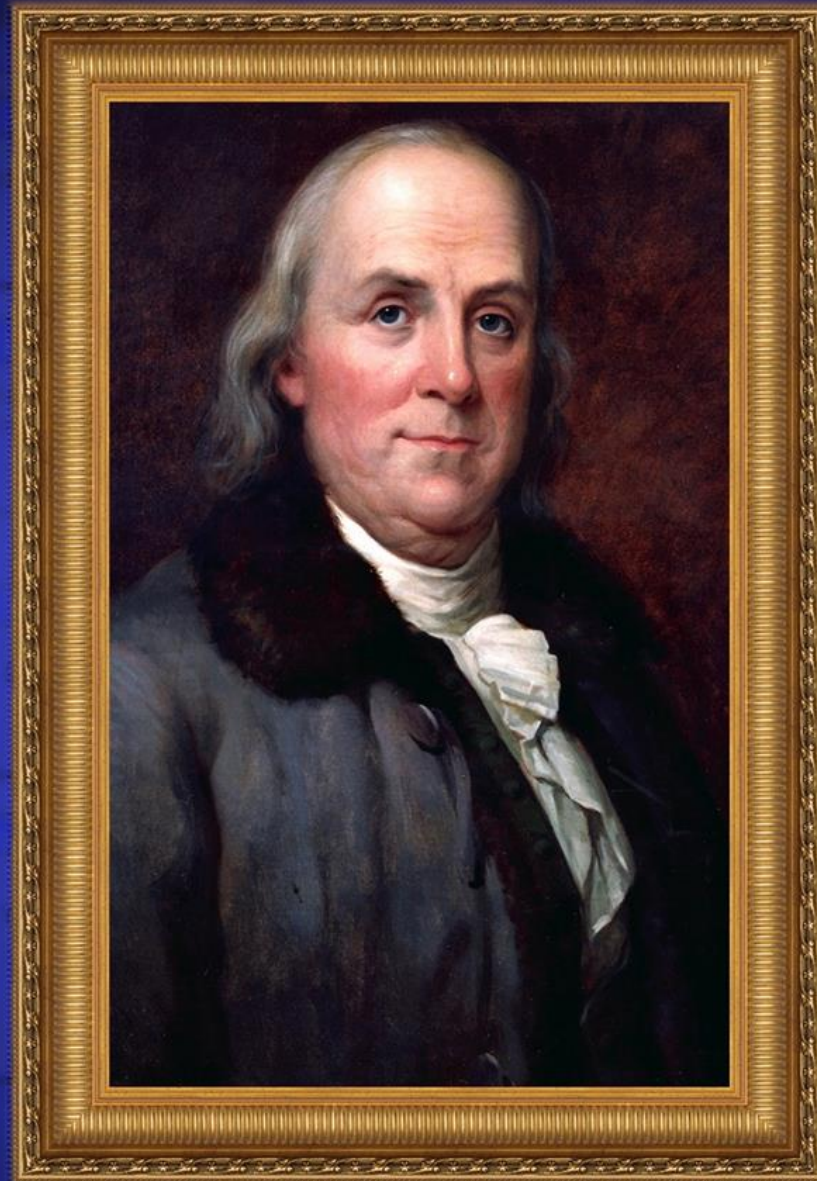

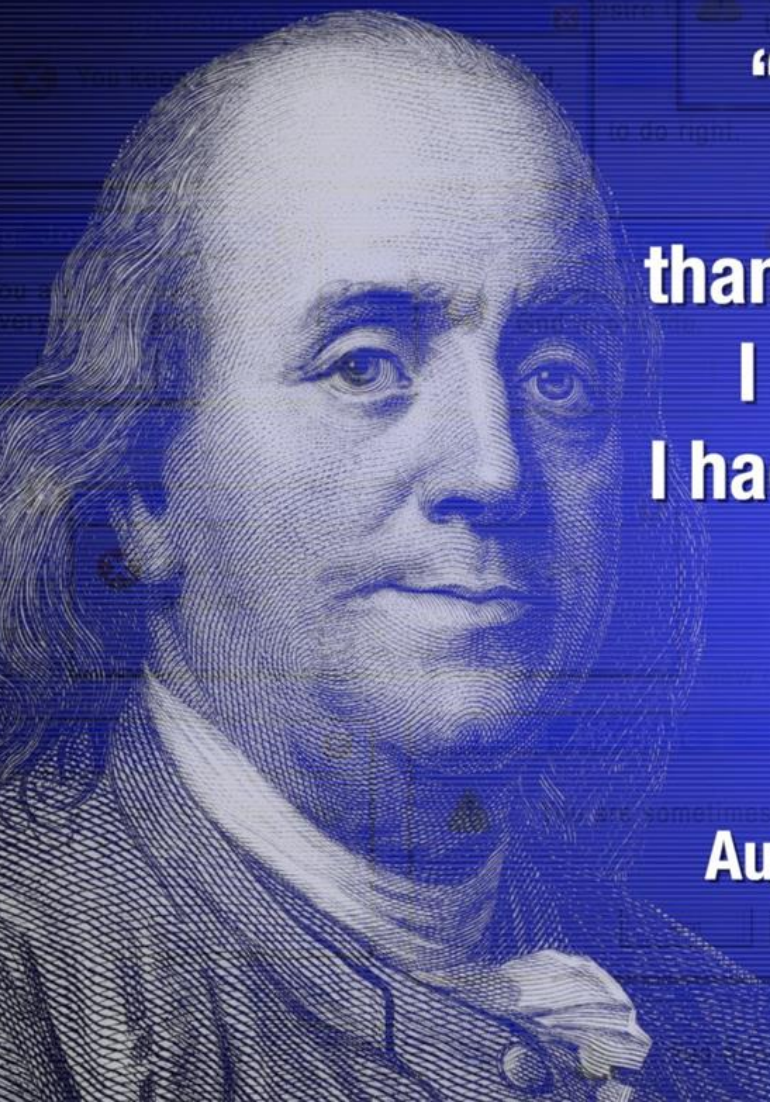
