Pray: Heavenly Father, thank you that you are so much greater than we are. Thank you that you have the power to create and destroy, and the power to bring desolations as well as make wars cease. God, you are God and we are not. Help us to properly understand this contrast, but also find both awe and comfort in it. Cause us to stand in awe of your power, and even have a fearful respect for what you are able to do. But help us also to be comforted by your power knowing that you are in control of all things – even our enemies – real and invisible. And thank you Lord that you have drawn very near to us in Jesus Christ... that in Him is all the power of the Godhead, but also our personal savior who died for us. Cause us to know that you love and care for each one of us, and that on the Last Day you will call us home into your presence, where we will witness your glory in a deeply personal way. In Jesus' Name. Amen.

<u>Do</u>: Make a list of all the ways that you see God's power and transcendence, then make another list of the ways you see him close to you in a personal way. Thank Him for both!
