The percentage of people who either believe there is no God, or do not know whether they believe there is a God, is increasing. The Bible assumes God's existence. How was Jesus involved at creation?

Is the existence of God a comforting thing, or a scary thing for you? Who do you know that needs to believe in God? Pray for them.





<sup>1</sup> The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.
 <sup>2</sup> Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge.
 <sup>3</sup> They have no speech, they use no words; no sound is heard from them.

<sup>4</sup> Yet their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world. "The occurrence of any change C presupposes some thing or substance S which changes. The existence of S at any given moment itself presupposes the concurrent actualization of S's potential for existence. So, any substance S has at any moment some actualizer A of its existence. If A's existence at the moment it actualizes S presupposes the concurrent actualization of its own potential for existence, then there exists a regress of concurrent actualizers that is either infinite or terminates in a purely actual actualizer."
