Even if someone believes there is a God, they often wonder if He cares about them or for them. Suffering can make us question God's goodness. The Bible, though it does not answer every question about suffering, is honest about the human struggle with suffering. This is what we see in history's most famous sufferer – Job.

The Question: "Is God Good?" ...

While he was yet speaking, there came another and said, "Your sons and daughters were eating and drinking wine in their oldest brother's house, and behold, a great wind came across the wilderness and struck the four corners of the house, and it fell upon the young people, and they are dead, and I alone have escaped to tell you." – Job 1:18-19

This can't be accidental Job's losses are devastating The way Job finds out is crushing!

Are you able to still praise God even in times of suffering?

How does knowing that God is all-powerful help in times of suffering?

Do you believe that God has a plan for your life?

Do you believe that God can work pain in your life into something good?

<u>Pray:</u> Heavenly Father, we are grateful that you are good. And like your servant Job, we know you are good regardless of what happens around us. So we choose to worship you and trust you even in the midst of pain and suffering. Lord, help us in our brokenness to cling to faith, to cling to hope, and to cling to your plan. Remind us Lord that you have a plan for us, and it is good. Remind us that you take even bad, difficult, and painful things in our life and work them together for our good. You can do this because you are all-powerful, and at the same time you are all-loving. Help us to trust you and to know that you are good – all of the time! In Jesus' Name, Amen.


LORD'S PRAYER
