There is no mistaking it: we are a culture that is confused about sex. But before we point our fingers out the sexual confusion "out there" in the world, we must take an honest look at the sexual temptation "in here" – in our hearts. God's boundaries for human sexuality are not meant to be restricting, but loving. They allow us to model God's love in our relationships.

Show us that when we try to resist sin in our own power, we are not as strong as when we allow you to guide and direct us by your Holy Spirit. Instead Lord, we invite you into our struggles – particularly those of lust. Remind us that you created sexuality to be a blessing between husband and wife and help us to create boundaries that preserve and protect that relationship. Send trusted friends to us who can speak into our lives words of rebuke and correction when necessary, but also who can be strong sources of encouragement as we share each other's struggles and burdens. May we not be dominated by lust in any area of our lives but surrender to your will for us. Forgive us when we fail and strengthen us in Christ to be guided by your Holy Spirit in us. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

- Ask God for the strength to follow His will each day.


