**COMMUNION INSTRUCTIONS:** As guided by ushers, approach the Altar from either side. Proceed as far to the rear of the rail on your side as possible. You may remain standing if you are not able to kneel. Once you have received both elements, a brief dismissal prayer is spoken, after which you may stand and return to your seat. If you are unable to come forward to receive Communion, remain at your seat and the pastor/elder(s) will come to you following the Communion distribution. *NOTE: The clear liquid in the middle of each individual-cup tray is a non-alcoholic fruit of the vine for communicants who must refrain from alcohol for any medical reason. Gluten-free wafers are available in the separate container on the paten (bread plate).*

**OUR COMMUNION BELIEFS:** We believe in the real presence of the body and blood of Christ in Holy Communion. (1 Cor. 11:23-29). We request that those who receive the Lord's Supper profess the following:

**I am a sinner. I have been baptized and believe that Jesus Christ gave His life so that I might be forgiven and live forever.** (John 6:54-56). **I believe that Jesus Christ is actually present in this meal and that together with the bread and wine I receive His true body and blood for the forgiveness of sins.** (Matthew 26:28).

*If this is not your belief or you've not yet received instruction about this sacrament, you may stay seated, or we invite you to come forward and place your hand over your heart and we will offer a prayer of blessing for you in lieu of the sacrament.*

**OFFERING:** In joyful response to God's grace in our lives, we humbly and gratefully offer our gifts to be used to spread the unfathomable love of God in Christ - the Light who shines in the darkness.
