It is always difficult to share your faith with a family member who does not believe. As we seek to share God's love with those who we love most, it is not just about our words, but about our lifestyles.

1 In the same way, wives, submit yourselves to your own husbands so that, even if some disobey the word, they may be won over without a word by the way their wives live 2 when they observe your pure, reverent lives.

– 1 Peter 3:1-2

Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

8 Finally, all of you be like-minded and sympathetic, love one another, and be compassionate and humble, 9 not paying back evil for evil or insult for insult but, on the contrary, giving a blessing, since you were called for this.
