Francis Pieper – prominent 1800s Lutheran Theologian The revelation of God's holiness teaches us two important lessons.

- In the first place, we must enter into His presence with deep awe and great reverence. Jehovah's throne is an awe-full throne, before which we are, as Abraham said, nothing but dust and ashes. (Genesis 18:27 as Abraham negotiated with God to spare Sodom)
- 2. But, secondly, we can come into His presence with confidence and joy, because the holiness of God has been perfectly appeased through Christ's vicarious atonement (Rom. 5:1, 10; Eph. 3:11-12).
