<sup>3</sup> who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases,

<sup>4</sup> who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion,

<sup>12</sup> as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.

<sup>13</sup> As a father has compassion on his children, so the LORD has compassion on those who fear him;

<sup>14</sup> for he knows how we are formed, he remembers that we are dust.

<sup>15</sup> The life of mortals is like grass, they flourish like a flower of the field;

<sup>16</sup> the wind blows over it and it is gone, and its place remembers it no more.

<sup>17</sup> But from everlasting to everlasting the LORD's love is with those who fear him, and his righteousness with their children's children— <sup>18</sup> with those who keep his covenant and remember to obey his precepts.

<sup>19</sup> The LORD has established his throne in heaven, and his kingdom rules over all.

<sup>20</sup> Praise the LORD, you his angels, you mighty ones who do his bidding, who obey his word.

<sup>21</sup> Praise the LORD, all his heavenly hosts, you his servants who do his will.

<sup>22</sup> Praise the LORD, all his works everywhere in his dominion.
